The Big Lottery Fund is the largest distributor of National Lottery money to good causes and invests up to £1 million every week in projects across Wales.

Together with the Welsh Assembly Government, the Big Lottery Fund is seeking to create more sustainable communities by supporting asset transfer from public authorities to enterprising community organisations. The **Community Asset Transfer programme** has a budget of approximately £13 million to distribute across Wales.

We are looking to recruit committee members to decide on how this money is spent. As a member of the Community Asset Transfer Programme Committee, you will have an excellent knowledge and understanding of some of the following issues, including asset acquisition and management, community regeneration, business management, economic sustainability, the third sector and local government.

Community Asset Transfer programme committee members will:

- decide on which grant applications should be funded based on assessment reports written by our officers
- advise on the priorities and strategic context of the programme
- contribute specific knowledge and expertise
- take a strategic overview of applications within the context of this programme.

Committee members will be expected to attend pre-arranged committee meetings on at least five occasions between June 2010 and spring 2012. Members are unpaid, but they may claim expenses. Committee meetings will be held at our offices in Cardiff and Newtown.
