Beaufort Hill Primary School	Blaenau Gwent	Beaufort Hill Primary School in Blaenau Gwent will use the grant to improve their playground facilities. This grant for £2,750 will fund an early years park.
Blaenau Gwent District Scouts	Blaenau Gwent	Blaenau Gwent District Scouts will use the grant to improve the Victoria Scout Campsite which will provide improved facilities for user groups. This grant for £4,500 will fund generator, lighting, gardening equipment, shelters, storage containers, seating and marketing materials.
Cwm Events Limited	Blaenau Gwent	Cwm Events Limited in Ebbw Vale will use the grant to purchase new equipment to improve the efficiency of the community events they regularly hold. This grant for £5,000 will fund a sound and lighting system, 16 high-vis vests, chain set plastic barriers, four radios, and three rock awning tents.

This grant for £4,635 will fund volunteer expenses, two laptops, membership development, outreach stalls, talks and events, a television and customer Fairtrade samples.
Tir-y-Berth Primary School	Caerphilly	Tir-y-Berth Primary School in Hengoed will use the grant to install an outdoor hexagonal stage, to be used by pupils and the local community as a creative and imaginative space. This grant for £5,000 will fund a hexagonal stage and playturf.
Cardiff People First	Cardiff	Cardiff People First will use the grant to employ a part-time member of staff to help people with learning disabilities to plan, organise and participate in 10 walks in the Brecon Beacons National Park. This grant for £4,135 will fund sessional worker costs, post and phone costs, travel costs, materials for walking activities, and a Brecon Beacons National Park Authority leaders fee.
Endeavourers	Cardiff	Endeavourers in Cardiff will use the grant to hold an end of year party for older and vulnerable people in the local community, to prevent social isolation. This grant for £500 will fund catering, entertainment, decorations, crackers, tablecloths, cupcakes, and venue hire.

The grant, of £5,000, will part-fund the purchase and installation of solar panels.
