Blaenau Gwent	Home-Start Blaenau Gwent	Home-Start Blaenau Gwent operate a fully functioning family centre where families can drop-in and access a structured timetable of activities such as play groups, craft sessions and job clubs. A variety of resources will be available including kitchen and wash facilities, and a toy library. £10,000 will fund staff costs, equipment and resources.
Blaenau Gwent	Special Movers	Special Movers in Blaenau Gwent will create a sensory space for their members, their families and the wider community. £5,350 will fund outdoor furniture, lighting, plants, shelter, sensory equipment and adaptations.
Bridgend	Bridgend Carers Centre	Bridgend Carers Centre will provide training and learning opportunities in skill areas such as communication, managing stress and anxiety and CV writing. It will also take young carers on trips and provide them with experiences that they may not otherwise get. £5,000 will fund activities, trips, training and equipment, and staffing costs.
Bridgend	Ysgol Bryn Castell	Ysgol Bryn Castell in Bridgend will provide specialist training to staff to deliver an extra-curricular sports club. £9,905 will cover training for six members of staff, equipment, stickers and certificates.
Caerphilly	Caerphilly Workmen's Hall	Caerphilly Workmen's Hall will provide an integrated sound system that will be easy to use, improve the facilities and expand the possibilities for future use of the hall. £9,845 will buy a sound system and related equipment.
Caerphilly	Friends of Inspire	Friends of Inspire in Caerphilly will expand their services to help those with long-term health conditions. £3,750 will fund a rowing machine, an exercise tutor, and hall rental.
Cardiff	29th Cardiff Scout Group	29th Cardiff Scout Group will replace outdated equipment and improve the conditions of activities for members. £6,600 will buy tents, airbags, paddles, and kayaks.
Cardiff	Family Action	Family Action in Cardiff will employ a new member of staff to recruit and train volunteers across Wales. These volunteers will, in turn, support parents with mental health problems or those at risk of developing them. £9,967 will support worker, training, insurance and travel costs.

Cardiff	Hayaat Women Trust	Hayaat Women Trust in Cardiff will deliver a trainer-led and peer support programme for 60 older Somali women to come together and exercise, socialise and learn new skills to help improve their health and well-being. £10,000 will pay for a Project Outreach Worker, instructor and volunteer expenses, refreshments, yoga mats and swimming costumes, publicity and marketing, project launch, venue hire, monitoring and evaluation.
Carmarthenshire	Canolfan Gymunedol Ystradowen Community Centre	Canolfan Gymunedol Ystradowen Community Centre will improve their support for older people by employing a driver for their minibus on a 10 month contract. £10,000 will cover the driver's salary.
Carmarthenshire	West Wales Motorcycle Project	West Wales Motorcycle Project in Carmarthen will provide start-up costs for the organisation to provide people living with mental health issues with opportunities to learn and socialise. This grant for £9,720 will fund venue hire, volunteer travel and replacement care, training, insurance, motorcycle parts, tools and equipment.
Ceredigion	The Good Companions	The Good Companions Group in Llandysul will fund a programme of social trips and purchase a camera and IT equipment to record and promote the activities of the group. This grant for £3,899 will cover transport, entrance fees, refreshments, office supplies, IT equipment and volunteer expenses.
Conwy	Aberconwy Mind	Aberconwy Mind in Conwy will deliver a new programme of four modules of six-week long accredited training sessions designed for those wanting to explore and understand their anger, as well as discovering some tools to manage these feelings on a day-to-day basis. £9,960 will be used to fund training costs, facilitator cost, overheads and promotional equipment.
Conwy	Abergele District Action Group	Abergele District Action Group will improve a community space so that it becomes a focus for local residents and provides a safe place for children to play. £5,649 will pay for installation of bird boxes, planters and a trim trail.

Denbighshire	The Carriageworks CIC	The Carriageworks CIC in Denbigh will deliver a range of self-exploration and art workshops in local villages and hold events and exhibitions to celebrate achievements and give local communities an opportunity to meet and share experiences and ideas. £8,370 will cover workshops, events, exhibitions, publicity, room hire and project management.
Gwynedd	Dolgellau Hearing Impaired Club	Dolgellau Hearing Impaired Club will organise a programme of activities for members, who are living with acquired hearing loss, to help relieve isolation and loneliness. £3,980 will fund coach hire, entrance fees, AGM room hire, and a closed loop system.
Merthyr Tydfil	Citizens UK Charity	Citizens UK Charity will use the grant to bring together the local community in Merthyr Tydfil to develop leaders and enable them to transform their communities for the common good. £9,000 will pay for training, community action resources, staff and volunteer costs and transport.
Merthyr Tydfil	Inspiring Hope	Inspiring Hope in Merthyr Tydfil will run a programme to help people improve their mental health and fitness. £10,000 will pay for Merthyr Girls Can and Merthyr Men Can programmes.
Merthyr Tydfil	Troedyrhiw Primary School	Troedyrhiw Primary School in Merthyr Tydfil will install a climbing frame for the whole community to use, improving the lack of playing facilities currently on offer. £10,000 will buy a climbing unit, play turf, and shock tiles.
Monmouthshire	1st Gilwern Scout Group	1st Gilwern Scout Group in Monmouthshire will take their entire group on a team partnership day to encourage team spirit and strengthen bonds between units. £2,500 will fund transport and entrance fees.

The group will also purchase camping equipment to replace the outdated items they currently use and help build their group. £10,000 will buy and fit kitchen appliances and units, flooring, electrics, sundries and camping equipment.
Neath Port Talbot	Swansea and Neath Port Talbot Young People's Foundation	Swansea and Neath Port Talbot Young People's Foundation will continue the fully inclusive youth provision in Clydach and Pontarddulais. The provision is free to access and the clubs are held twice weekly. £9,980 will cover the Youth Worker salaries, venue hire and activity costs.
Newport	Circles Network	Circles Network will work with people with disabilities in the Newport area; building support structures and providing care and support to both service users and their carers. £9,980 will pay for facilitator costs, travel, training, equipment, communications and marketing.
Newport	Stow Park Community Centre	Stow Park Community Centre in Newport will establish a series of life skills sessions for people who are vulnerably housed, homeless, or on low incomes. £6,240 will pay for three sewing machines and related equipment, planters and gardening tools, kitchen refurbishment and utensils, translation, staff and volunteer expenses and publicity.
Pembrokeshire	Adam's Bucketful of Hope Appeal Limited	Adam's Bucketful of Hope Appeal Limited in Pembrokeshire will raise awareness of the services on offer and the development of a Bucketful of Hope choir. £3,800 will pay for filming, editing and film licences.
Powys	1st Crickhowell and Llangattock Scout Group	1st Crickhowell & Llangattock Scout Group will commence a programme of works prioritising the replacement of the floor in the Scout Hall. £10,000 will be a contribution to the installation of a new, insulated floor.

Rhondda Cynon Taf	Canolfan Pentre CIO	Canolfan Pentre CIO in Rhondda Cynon Taf will refit the areas of their well-attended community centre that are falling into disrepair. £9,400 will upgrade the toilet block and front and back doors.
Rhondda Cynon Taf	Hirwaun YMCA	Hirwaun YMCA in Rhondda Cynon Taff will hold cooking and digital skills workshops for young people, to improve their health and employability. £9,704 will provide a sessional worker, ingredients, media workshops, book writing and design workshops, cookery book printing, a presentation night and subsistence.
Rhondda Cynon Taf	Tonyrefail Community Defibrillators	Tonyrefail Community Defibrillators in Rhondda Cynon Taff will use the grant to install life-saving equipment which has been requested by the community, who have shown their support for the project by organising fundraising activities and offering their skills to deliver it. This grant for £10,000 will buy defibrillators.
Rhondda Cynon Taf	Trehafod Shotokan Karate Club	Trehafod Shotokan Karate Club in Rhondda Cynon Taff will buy equipment to help teach self-discipline, calmness and a more positive attitude towards life, which in turn will help minimise anti-social behaviour in the community. £2,160 will cover venue hire, equipment, and training courses.
Swansea	Glais Community Centre	Glais Community Centre in Swansea will improve the building for wider usage by the local community. £9,000 will fund new internal walls, a suspended ceiling and lighting.

The Vale of Glamorgan	Cowbridge Food Festival Limited	Cowbridge Food Festival Limited in the Vale of Glamorgan will use the grant to create better understanding of food poverty and food waste by offering a series of workshops, demonstrations and the dissemination of information at the festival. £7,940 will pay for a project manager, electricity, tents, security, speaker' fees, demonstrations, printing, a fridge, transport, insurance and marketing.
Wrexham	The National Trust For Places Of Historic Interest Or Natural Beauty	The National Trust For Places Of Historic Interest Or Natural Beauty will use the grant to provide vulnerable families in Wrexham with opportunities to improve relationships and to learn new skills. £9,310 will buy tents, sleeping bags and mats, outdoor foldable furniture, torches and lanterns, burns kits, cooking equipment, food, storage containers and a fire pit.
Wrexham	Wrexham Tennis Centre Limited	Wrexham Tennis Centre Limited will run a series of courses for women and visually impaired people using different variations of tennis with the intention of having fun rather than achieving sporting excellence. £3,662 will fund Level 4 coach and indoor courts for sessions, and tennis balls.
